Livestock Judging

At these contests, there are four animals in a class that are placed, consisting of cattle, swine, sheep, and goats. This program is a wonderful way for kids to build confidence and improve their decisionmaking skills.

Major Show Turkey Order

If you are interested in showing turkeys at the major livestock shows next year, please contact the Extension Office 830.672.8531 prior to August 07, 2025 so poults can be ordered.



Major Broiler Orders





Deadline-September 12th \$37.50/box of 25 chicks. All major livestock show broiler orders (**San Antonio, Houston, and Austin**) need to be ordered by September 12th.



Major Market Goat & Lamb Breeding Goat & Sheep

If you desire to show market goats, market lambs, breeding goats or breeding sheep, wether dams or wether does at any of the major livestock shows this coming year, your projects will need to be validated and tagged on *October 14th*. In order for this to occur, you must call the AgriLife Extension office by *September 29th* to order the ear tags that will be placed in your project.





Texas 4-H & FFA Heifer Validation

Again, this fall, there will be a major show heifer validation for any 4-H or FFA member wanting to exhibit heifers at the major livestock shows (Ft. Worth, San Antonio, Houston, Austin, Waco & Dallas). The animal ownership deadline and registration papers will need to be transferred to the exhibitor before this validation.

The heifers must be tagged, tattooed, brands recorded, and hair samples will be collected for a DNA assay. There will be a \$25 charge per heifer validated. The validation will occur on October 16th, at the Pecan Grove Vet. Clinic from 5-6:00 pm. Previously major show validated heifers do not need to be revalidated unless there is a change of ownership or breed. If you have heifers to validate, please call the Extension Office by August 27th to order your ear tags.



This will also serve as validation for the Gonzales County Youth Show Halter Heifer Show.

Texas 4-H & FFA Swine Validation





All hogs that will be shown in the major shows must be validated to be eligible to participate. Validation will be held on November 20th from 5-6pm @JB Wells. To assist us with ordering validation ear tags, please contact the Extension office by September 22nd. If you do not order your tags, then you cannot show your animals later.







Gonzales County Youth Show Sheep, Goat, and Halter Heifer Exhibitors

Validation for the lambs and goats will occur Tuesday, October 14, 2025 5:00 to 6:00 pm at the JB Wells Park.

Validation for the halter heifers will occur Thursday, October 16, 2025 5:00-6:00 pm at the Pecan Grove Vet. Clinic.


