Expectations form 4-H Members:

- Members must be 14 years of age at the beginning of the 2025-2026 4-H Year.
- There will be a maximum of 2 ambassadors per project area. There are 5 project areas (Ag and Livestock, STEM, Natural Resources, Family & Community Health, and Leadership/Citizenship)
- Each Ambassador team is responsible for conducting 1 project-oriented workshop per year. Communication and teamwork with the Agents is a must. Examples of workshops are Livestock Clinic for Livestock Ambassadors, Tour of Game Ranch for Natural Resources, Photography Workshop for STEM.
- Each Ambassador is required to attend a minimum of one (1) club meeting other than their own club, and advocate for the project area they are an ambassador for.
- There will be a community service project ties to each workshop. Examples could be a canned food drive, coat drive, cleanup of county or city property.
- Ambassadors will be expected to participate in the Annual Awards Recognition Banquet and Fundraising.
