

Americans with Disability Act of 1990:

Individuals with disabilities who require an auxiliary aid, service, or accommodation in order to participate in any 4-H event are encouraged to contact the County Extension Office (361.595.8566) at least two weeks in advance of the program to see how reasonable accommodations can be made.

School Eligibility:

Kleberg-Kenedy County AgriLife Extension Service complies with the law set forth by legislature regarding eligibility and school absences. Members competing or simply participating in a 4-H event (judging events, presentations, livestock shows, etc.) must be certified as eligible to participate by their respective school. School Officials will be provided with a list of students entered in competitive/non-competitive 4-H events. Should a student be ineligible according to their school, 4-H members will be notified in writing of their ineligibility statues by our office.



<u>4-H Club Charter:</u>

4-H Clubs that did not submit the required charting information will not appear in next year's enrollment. This will affect members enrolling for the 2024-2025 4-H year.

4-H enrollment for the 2024-2025 4-H year opens on August 15th!
If you are planning on participating in KKJLS or any other 4-H projects, you must register online.
