



Americans with Disability Act of 1990:

Individuals with disabilities who require an auxiliary aid, service, or accommodation in order to participate in any 4-H event are encouraged to contact the County Extension Office (361.595.8566) at least two weeks in advance of the program to see how reasonable accommodations can be made.

School Eligibility:

Kleberg-Kenedy County AgriLife Extension Service complies with the law set forth by legislature regarding eligibility and school absences. Members competing or simply participating in a 4-H event (judging events, presentations, livestock shows, etc.) must be certified as eligible to participate by their respective school. School Officials will be provided with a list of students entered in competitive/non-competitive 4-H events. Should a student be ineligible according to their school, 4-H members will be notified in writing of their ineligibility statues by our office.

Banquet: 5:00 p.m. **Theme:** "Race to be the Best in 4-H"







This loan program is available to 4-H and FFA members involved junior market, breeding and commercial livestock projects.

The funds can be used to purchase and care for a junior livestock project or for a general purpose youth agricultural loan and must be repaid following the sale of the animal(s). The AgStart Loan Program is designed to offer educational and financial awareness to youth while supporting the next generation of farmers and ranchers.



Applicants will need to create a simple profile on Submittable to complete the application. The application requires (among other details) several written narratives, a 2–3-minute personal video narrative, as well as two letters of recommendations.

Eligibility for New Members

- A Texas 4-H member entering the 9th 12th grade (as of September 1, 2024).
- Complete and submit the application by July 31, 2024.
- · Have a willingness to learn about and promote STEM.
- · Attend a mandatory virtual orientation along with his/her parents/guardians on August 29 at 7 PM.
- Attend the mandatory fall and spring in-person meetings (dates will be listed in the application).
- . Be willing to work collaboratively on a team with other youth and adults.
- · Be responsive and engaged in team communications.
- Share knowledge and skills with others.
- Not serving on the 2024-25 Texas 4-H Council.
- Applications will be reviewed in August and applicants notified by the August 25th.
