#### SUBJECT: 2025 District 12 4-H Meat Judging Contest

The 2025 District 12 4-H Meat Judging Contest will be held concurrently with the San Antonio Livestock Exposition's (SALE) Meat Judging Contest. The event will be held on Sunday, February 16, 2025 in San Antonio at the Colorado Boxed Beef Co. Registration will be held in Colorado Boxed Beef Co. The contest will be open to all three age divisions and follow the same guidelines outlined in the Texas 4-H Roundup Rules and Guidelines as they relate to this contest. It is important to remember that the SALE Meat Judging Contest Rules will also apply. In addition to the recognition provided directly to contestants as part of the SALE event, those registered through the District 12 4-H Meat Judging Contest on <u>4-H Online</u> will also be recognized separately.

#### Registration:

There will be a dual registration for participants in this contest to be included as part of the District competition. Contestants will have to pay two separate fees. <u>Entry requires completion</u> of both listed below.

- District 12 Entry via <u>4-H Online</u> Each participant must be registered on <u>4-H Online</u>. The registration period will be open from <u>November 1, 2024 through December 1, 2024</u>. Registration fees are to cover the cost of awards and recognition for District 12 contestants only. There will be a \$12 registration fee, per person, to cover District awards.
- 2) SALE Entry Counties must complete entries required by San Antonio Livestock Exposition and submit along with other livestock show entries by the standard December 1<sup>st</sup> deadlines. Participants should consult with local county offices for local entry deadlines. Counties must follow SALE entry requirements to be considered "entered" in the contest. The standard SALE registration fee will also apply (\$40/team). <u>SALE requires a social security number at sign-in</u>. Keep in mind that SALE registration does not require names, only the number of teams entered. However, names must be reflected in <u>4-H Online</u> registration.

#### Contest Details:

It is important that the SALE Premium List regarding the Meat Judging contest be reviewed thoroughly for a full list of classes and details (*Attachment A*). There will not be any reasons classes for any age division.

SALE offers only Senior and Junior divisions. As a result, Intermediates must register as a Junior for the purposes of their contest. However, team designation forms will allow us to determine which "Junior" teams are Intermediates and which are Juniors for the District 12 Contest. **REMINDER!** For the District team designation only: Senior teams can only include Senior 4-H members. We cannot allow Juniors or Intermediates to be included on Senior Team Designation Forms due to State and National team rules.

The contest will be held in the Colorado Boxed Beef Co., 4231 Profit Dr #A San Antonio, TX 78219. Sign-in will take place between 7:00 a.m. and 7:45 a.m., with the contest beginning promptly at 8:00 a.m., so be prompt. Participants must check-in with San Antonio <u>and</u> the District 12 Superintendent prior to the contest starting.

#### Team Designation:

Teams will be designated for the SALE contest at sign-in. At that time, all District 12 teams must be recorded via D12 Team Designation Form <u>before</u> the contest begins and turned into the District 12 contest superintendent on-site. A form will be provided by the District superintendent.

The contest will be open to all three age divisions and follow the same guidelines outlined in the Texas 4-H Roundup Rules and Guidelines as they relate to this contest. It is important to remember that the SALE Horse Judging Contest Rules will also apply. In addition to the recognition provided directly to contestants as part of the SALE event, those registered through the District 12 4-H Horse Judging Contest on <u>4-H Online</u> will also be recognized separately.

#### Registration:

There will be a dual registration for participants in this contest to be included as part of the District competition. Contestants will have to pay two separate fees. <u>Entry requires completion</u> of both listed below.

- District 12 Entry via <u>4-H Online</u> Each participant must be registered on <u>4-H Online</u>. The registration period will be open from <u>November 1, 2024 through December 1, 2024</u>. Registration fees are to cover the cost of awards and recognition for District 12 contestants only. There will be a \$12 registration fee, per person, to cover District awards.
