Lubbock County Parent Leaders 4-H Scholarship

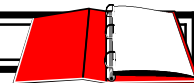
The Lubbock County Parent Leaders Association is sponsoring a Scholarship Program for county 4-H youth completing their Senior High School year.

The Gold Star application is on the County website under Program Areas – 4-H then scroll down to Publications. The revised Gold Star Interview scorecard is also on the County website.

County Workshop

If you haven't attended a county recordbook workshop, please contact Ronda to be sure you are using the correct forms if you plan to complete a 4-H recordbook. The recordbook consists of a binder (doesn't have to be a 4-H binder), the personal information page, the 4-H story and photo portfolio and the District 2 or Senior 4-H Report form. All of these forms are available on the County website. The 4-H Recordbook Participant Guidelines will also assist you in putting the correct information together. For intermediate and juniors - **DO NOT** use the forms off of the State 4-H website – they are different.

A beginner's Record Book workshop will be held on **Wednesday, May 29 at 2-6pm** at the County Extension Office. Bring all of your recordbook questions and materials to begin work on your recordbook. Please call the County Extension Office, 775-1740, by May 28 if you plan on attending the training. If you are interested in doing a recordbook, but have not been able to attend a training, please contact Ronda for more options.

County recordbook Judging will be held on **Tuesday, June 18**, beginning at 1:00 pm through 8 pm. All volunteers are welcomed to assist with judging. Judging is a great way to learn more about the process. Please RSVP to Ronda by June 17, if you can assist!

Remember: Recordbooks are due to the County Extension Office on Monday, June 17, 2024 by 5 pm.

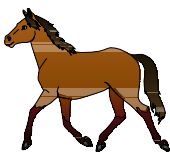

The next 4-H Newsletter will not be mailed until the middle of July, so please make note of deadline dates in this newsletter.


Teen Council Garage Sale

Lubbock County 4-H - Parade of Champions Award

In order to recognize Lubbock County 4-H'ers for their involvement and achievement, the 4-H Awards and Recognition committee has created a new recognition for the County 4-H Achievement Banquet. 4-H'ers who are eligible for the Parade of Champions will receive a specially designed 4-H t-shirt or item at the County 4-H Achievement Banquet, which will be held on August 4; you must attend the Banquet to receive your item. This application must be completed for each 4-H'er applying for the "Parade of Champions" Award. **To be eligible, a 4-H'er must have competed in at least one County/District/State Competition and participated in either a project meeting, tour, workshop or community service activity, conducted through Lubbock County 4-H from August 15, 2023 - June 17, 2024.** (You may participate in more than two activities, but you will only receive one t-shirt. Clover 4-H'ers are not eligible to apply.) **The application is due to the County Extension Office by Monday, June 17 – NO EXCEPTIONS!**
