You may begin new enrollment after **August 15.** New members will need to set up a 4-H profile, please contact Ronda if you need assistance. For 3rd graders - please wait until **September 1**; otherwise you will be categorized as a Clover.

If you plan to work at the 4-H Barnyard, you need to be enrolled on 4-H Online before the event.

Ear tags can be ordered at the County Extension Office from now until the tag order deadline date and must be paid for at the time of the tag order. All lambs, barrow and goats must be validated for the Lubbock County Junior Livestock Show held in January 2025, as well as the major shows.

Lamb/Goat Program:

Anticipated Deadline to Order Ear Tags - August 19, 2024



Cost - \$20.00 per animal

Validation Dates - October, 2024

Procedure - Ear tag, nose print, tattoo, DNA Sample, and complete forms.

Swine Program:

Anticipated Deadline to Order Ear Tags - Approximately

September 18, 2024

Cost - \$20.00 per barrow

Validation Dates - November, 2024

Procedure - Ear tag, identify ear notches, DNA sample, and complete forms.
