- Any breeding animal showing at Major Shows MUST have health papers completed by a veterinarian
 - Major Livestock Shows no longer require original registration papers, copies will now be accepted.
- Exhibitors must familiarize themselves with the Texas 4-H Livestock Ethics Policy <u>found here.</u>
 - If your animal is out of your possession for ANY reason, or for any amount of time, a <u>Rule 3 Form MUST</u> be submitted to the Extension Office ahead of time.
