Burnet County 4-H took a total of 13 kids to State 4-H Roundup and brought home 3 State Championships! Indoor Rifle, Consumer Decision Making and Photography Judging all claimed victory, along with several other teams such as livestock judging, wool judging, healthy lifestyles and wildlife challenge earning placings. The Burnet County 4-H Consumer Decision Making Team will represent Texas at the National contest later this year.



Indoor Rifle

Burnet County 4-H Rifle, coached by volunteer Guy Taylor, claimed a State Title in Victoria on June 1st, breaking a State Record in the process. Senior 4-H member Morgan Sitra also won 1st place Individual as the team became the second Texas 4-H team to ever break the 1700 mark in an Indoor Rifle match.

- You are responsible for educating yourself on all rules for any stock show or contest that you enter. If you need help getting to those rules, give us a call at 512-756-5463
- Any breeding animal showing at Major Shows **MUST** have health papers completed by a veterinarian
 - Major Livestock Shows no longer require original registration papers, copies will now be accepted.
- Exhibitors must familiarize themselves with the Texas 4-H Livestock Ethics Policy [found here](#).
- If your animal is out of your possession for **ANY** reason, or for any amount of time, a [Rule 3 Form](#) **MUST** be submitted to the Extension Office ahead of time.
