An annual fee is required for all members and volunteers. Starting August 15, 2025, the participant fee is \$25.00 if enrolled from August 15th to October 31st. After this date the fee will increase to \$30.00. Adults pay a \$10 Volunteer application fee.

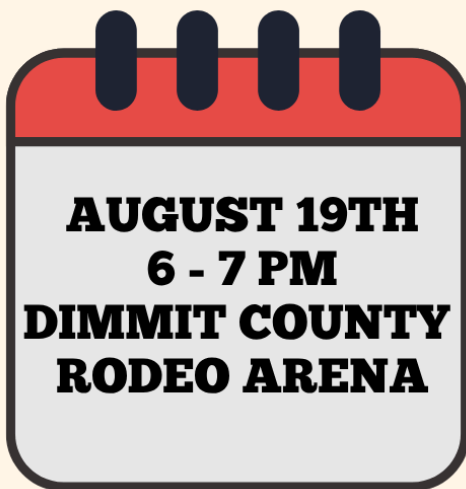

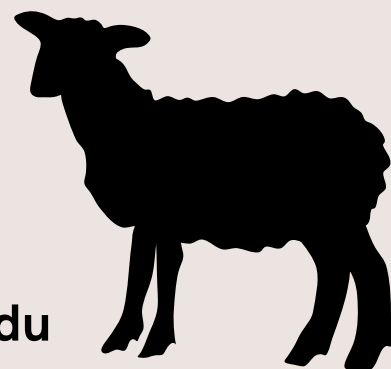
2025-2026 TEXAS 4-H & FFA SHEEP & GOAT VALIDATION TAG ORDER

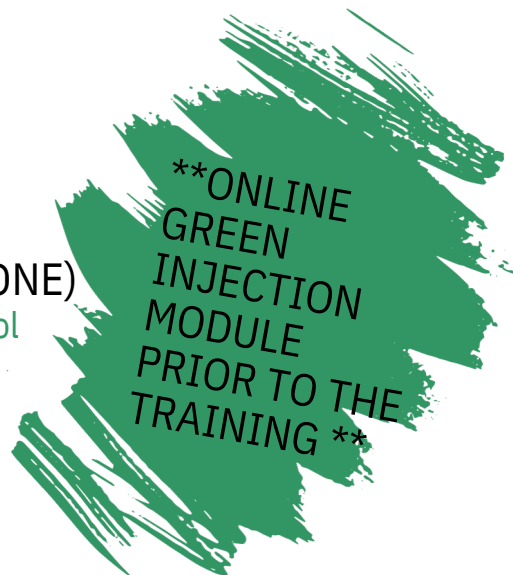
