<u>Information:</u> Please utilize the PDF resources below to help new and returning families navigate the 4HOnline system and re-enroll as soon as possible. Remember to access 4HOnline here: https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in

- · **Youth Enrollment Fee (\$25):** Youth may participate in the 4-H year from September 1st of grade three through August 31st following completion of grade twelve, with these age restrictions:
- o Minimum Age 8 (as of September 1, 2025, in addition to being in the 3rd grade) o Maximum Age 18 (as of September 1, 2025)
- · Clover Enrollment Fee (\$10): Youth who are minimum of five years old AND eligible to enroll in Kindergarten on September 1 of the current year and have no started the 3rd grade on September 1.
- · Adult Enrollment Fee (\$10): Adults who have surpassed their 18th birthday and are no longer enrolled in school by September 1.




