No longer will there be a county only option for validation on steers, sheep, goats, or swine.

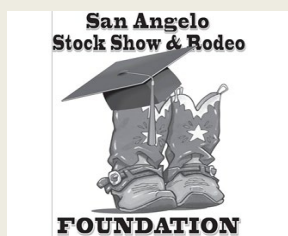

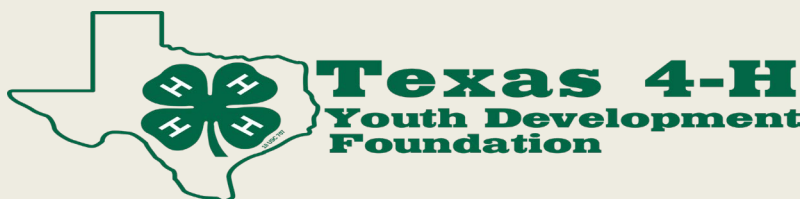

# Strategies for Selecting Market Broilers for Show

## Pen Selection

- Do not over handle the birds.
- Too much feeling, squeezing, and hanging upside down creates stress on the birds and causes birds to soften and possibly die.

Remember, prior to pen selection look for defects that would result in disqualification. Remove those birds (if any) and select the top birds for a pen to show.

- Mark bird on the leg with magic/paint marker. Mark the first choice pen of birds all the same.
- Mark alternate birds with a different color or mark for quick identification.
- Avoid tie wraps, string or leg bands for identification purposes.

## Criteria for Pen Selection:

- Length of breast bone – Measure from the “V” in the breast to the end point of the breast (keel) bone.
  - The longer the breast (keel) bone the better!
- Depth of body – The measurement from the front of the breast to the backbone should be considered.
  - Deep bodied birds will exhibit more muscle mass!
- Width of the breast muscle – Using your hand, measure the width of the breast muscle
  - Wide breasted birds are desired!
- Tapering of the breast – measure the amount of taper (loss of muscling) as you evaluate the breast muscle toward the back of the breast (keel) bone.
  - Minimal amount of taper is best!

At the beginning of show week - Begin to prepare for transport of birds to the show.

Locate cardboard box and purchase fresh shavings (shavings from house not recommended unless they are exceptionally clean)

Ensure availability of additional people to assist in holding birds for pen selection. If it is a morning show, select birds the night before. If it is an afternoon/evening show, select birds the morning of the show in cool weather only. During hot weather, select birds after 9:00 p.m. prior to show.

You've spent countless hours in the barn. You've managed the nutrition of your show string, grown and worked hair and now you are ready to hit the spring shows. The work you've put in at the barn is important, but so is transporting your projects to the show so they are safe and comfortable.

Billy Stuckey, Sherman, Texas, says joint health and keeping cattle sound while hauling them is imperative. "Make sure they are comfortable, and if you can, leave them loose to haul them."

The first thing Stuckey likes to do when preparing his trailer to haul cattle to a winter show is to lay down a half-inch thick rubber mat on the floor of the trailer. These mats can be purchased at most farm stores and gives an initial layer of comfort between the trailer floor and the animals. Next, he likes to use fine-textured bedding like cedar fiber or pellets to bed the trailer. He suggests wetting down and packing the bedding until it is 3-6 inches thick.

"Wetting the bedding down keeps it packed in tight and makes nice padding for the cattle, and it keeps the bedding from blowing around and getting in their eyes and hair," Stuckey said.

Straw is a less expensive bedding alternative; however, Stuckey suggests that if using straw, the bed should be at least 8-10 inches deep to ensure the cattle have enough padding. He also recommends keeping the rubber mats on the trailer floor to provide added comfort and prevent slipping. Straw will get dirty more quickly, and it would likely take more to bed the same area.

"You will get a more comfortable ride on shavings or cedar," Stuckey said. "The bedding is more likely to stay in place when the cattle are moving, and the shavings are easier to keep clean."

Once you have a good bed for your cattle, decide if you have enough room to leave them loose while in the trailer. If space allows, group small numbers of similar sized cattle together, leaving them enough room to lie down. If you must tie up your cattle, allow 3-4 feet per head so they can lie down, and tie them low.

Before you leave, also make sure all gates are secured and locked. If you have more than a 12-15 hour drive, you might want to find a place to stop over for 6-8 hours, allowing the cattle to eat and get some exercise. This will also allow you to get some rest.

"Keeping your cattle safe and comfortable should be a priority," Stuckey said. "Provide them a comfortable, padded trailer to make sure they are sound when you get to your show."

Finally, Stuckey recommends cleaning and rebedding the trailer on a regular basis – at least monthly. This ensures your cattle have a clean, safe environment and also prevents the trailer floor from rotting, extending the life of your trailer.



As things are heating up across the country, both in temperature and competition in the ring, it is important to pay attention to the most vital nutrient...WATER. High quality drinking water is key to ensure that you have healthy and productive animals that feel good come show day.

However, sometimes the quality of the water isn't the issue. Sometimes your animal simply does not want to drink! So, here's a few tips to make sure your animal stays hydrated when traveling to shows.

1. If it's the animals first time at a show, make sure they know how to drink out of a water bucket. Some animals struggle with having to drink out of a bucket if they are not used to doing it at home. Prior to going to the show, try watering your animal a few times with the bucket so they are acclimated to it upon arrival.
2. Always make sure you have a clean water source. Don't let full water buckets or pig troughs sit out and get infested with dirt and then try to water. Always get a clean bucket or fresh water for you animal when it is time to water them.
3. Some exhibitors find using a water filter at home and at the show will help keep water tasting consistent. Consistency is key to ensure animals stay drinking water.
4. Consider adding electrolytes to your water at home. Not only will your animals get their daily dose of vitamins to help stimulate their digestive system, but the flavor will become familiar to them and helps mask some of the foreign taste of chlorine in "city water" when on the show road.
