Criteria for County 4-H Council Nomination:

1. The Chairperson, 1st Vice-Chairperson, and Delegate-at-Large must be 16 years of age
2. Eligible candidates - 6th grade – 12th grade
3. All candidates must have attended two county 4-H Council meetings of the current year. They do not have to attend as a voting delegate from their respective club.
4. An officer is not eligible to serve in the same office for more than one term.
5. There shall be no more than two officers elected from any one club unless there are not eligible candidates who meet criteria to run for office. The Chairperson and the Delegate-at-large cannot be from the same club.
