2. Attend 2/3 of regular club meetings.	Member must be present at 2/3 of regular club meetings. No excused absences.

Participate in a 4-H contest on the county or district level.	Includes any event listed in the current Roundup guide. Examples: Food Challenge, Quiz Bowls, Fashion Show, Educational Presentations, Judging Contests.				
Participate in a contest or event on the state level.	Can include Roundup events such as Food Challenge, Quiz Bowls, Fashion Show, Educational Presentations, Judging Contests, Etc. Major livestock shows as well as other state level 4-H events are also included.				
Turn in a complete 4-H Record Book.	Submit a complete 4-H Record Book to the Extension office by the required due date (usually June).				
Research college/career opportunities.	Activities that have helped you learn more about careers or the necessary education to enter a career. Examples of activities include: interviews, tours, job shadowing, research, mentoring, work experience, skill development, course work, etc.				
Participate in a County, District, State or National Leadership Training.	District Leader Lab participation will meet this requirement as well as other state level events.				
Serve on a committee or as an elected officer.	Includes offices or committees served on at project group, club, or county level.				

Serve on a county 4-H committee.	Serve as an active member on any county 4-H committee. Can include 4-H Council or other committees.				
Serve as a Junior or Teen Leader or assist with providing a learning experience for other 4-H members or youth.	Assist leader or provide primary leadership for a project group, club or activity. Includes leadership provided alone or as part of a group.				
Assist in conducting a county 4-H activity or program.	Includes any county-wide event or activity that you assisted with or were assigned a duty.				
Participate in a community service project.	Community service or service learning projects which might include: clean ups, collections, repairs, construction, care packets, visitations, education, donations, or presentations. Participate, either as individual or group member.				
Organize and/or provide leadership to a community service project.	Community service or service learning projects which might include: clean ups, collections, repairs, construction, care packets, visitations, education, donations, or presentations. Plan, either as individual, group or committee member and carry out community service project.				
Share Information about 4-H to other groups.	Share information about 4-H with other organizations or groups.				
Participate in 4-H promotion activities.	Can include activities that promote 4-H through the use of: promotional exhibits, news articles, interviews on radio/TV, social media, direct contacts, etc.				
Participate in a school or community activity.	Includes involvement in other organizations or activities outside of 4-H.
